Staff Report

Homosaurus Statistics

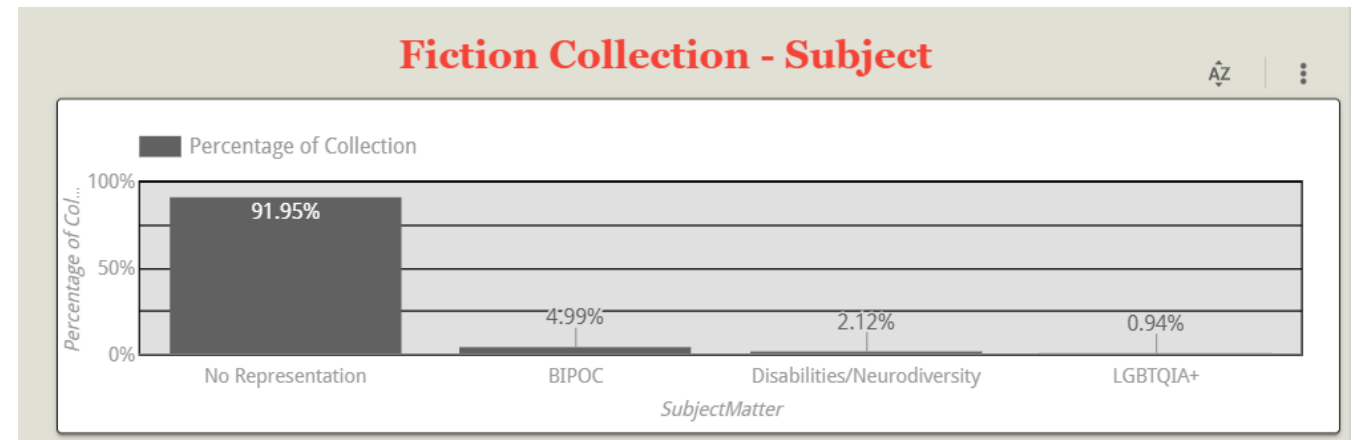
- Number of Homosaurus Authority Records: 189
- Number of Records with Homosaurus Terms: 890
- Which Homosaurus terms are in the catalog?
 - A link to a list is in the Homosaurus Catalog Wiki page.
 - Try the saved “Homosaurus Records” SQL Query in the authority record find tool.

- Adding Homosaurus headings to OCLC master records can benefit other libraries and prevent overlaid records from erasing the headings.

Polaris 7.0 Update

- The 7.0 update added most cataloging features to Leap.
- What's missing?
 - Overlaying MARC records manually
 - Printing labels
- A new course on cataloging in Leap will be created by the end of September or beginning of October.
- New sections will be added to the Serials in Leap course and the Record Sets in Leap course.
- Two webinars will be scheduled after the courses have been completed:
 - Polaris 7.0 Update Overview
 - Bulk Changes in Leap
- Production server will be upgraded during the end of October or beginning of November.

Diversity Audit Data Dashboard Update

- The dashboard analyzes the subject headings for diversity of subject matter and allows selectors to identify items not owned by the library .
- This week we are conducting UX testing of the prototype.
- After the initial user testing, we will add in additional categories and tweak its functionality based on the feedback of the UX testing.
- Additional UX testing will be completed after the dashboard has been updated.



New Item Material Type

- At the August 3rd meeting, Database Management decided to create a new material type: Other Audiobook.
- Cassette Audiobook will be relabeled.
- Other Audiobook can be used for cassettes and any new formats like Yoto.
- The material type was changed on August 13th.

Proposal under consideration

- Palatine proposed to allow a set of local diversity subject headings for all libraries
- It would be in the 690 field, not the 691 field with the city in the \$a preceding the heading the \$x
- These headings could benefit any libraries interested in diversity audits, provide additional access points, or be used for making record sets on these subjects.
- Proposed local headings:
 - Own voices
 - BIPOC author
 - BIPOC subject
 - LGBTQIA author
 - LGBTQIA subject
 - Neurodiverse subject
 - Neurodiverse author
 - Disability author
 - Disability subject
 - Intersectionality
 - Diversity subject

Reminders

Quality control issues

- Remove invalid subject headings, i.e. Spanish language materials, Star Wars fiction, Suspense fiction (and other gsaft), Sony video games.
- Do not overlay records with Homosaurus headings when using Z39.50 to import records.
 - Example: 650 7 \$a Latinx (LGBTQ) \$2 homoit
- Do not forget to review records for mistakes to correct.
 - Full level records can still have mistakes in them.
 - ISBNs in the wrong records can cause accidental merges.
 - Verify that the title and pagination are correct.
 - Use the correct TOMs.
- Verify that the correct records are being merged. Although it is easy to reimport records, verifying holds is very time consuming.

Visible links in PAC

- If you would like a link to a resource (856) to be visible in the PAC use:
 - 1st indicator – 4 (HTTP)
 - 2nd indicator – 0 (Resource)

Missing Volumes

- Don't forget to contact a library if they need to add or correct volumes.
- Regularly checking the missing volume reports by using the saved SQL query in the find tool improves how holds are placed.
- Saved SQL queries can be accessed from the Item Find Tool:
 - Has No Volume But Others Do
 - Has Volume But Others Don't
 - Only the AssignedBranchID number needs to be changed.

Delete Withdrawn Items

- A report uncovered many withdrawn records that hadn't been deleted.
- Please remind your staff that all withdrawn records need to be deleted before they can be purged from the system.
- Records can be bulk deleted from a record set by selecting all records in the record set.
- You can regularly check for withdrawn records by using a saved SQL query of the item record find tool.
- Only the AssignedBranchID number needs to be changed.
