OLD BUSINESS

- 6. <u>Study Program Information Note</u> indicates Guided Reading Level should be in 526, but the page for <u>Lexile</u> has an example that indicates GRL should be in 521. 526 is the correct field, but 521 is easier to search. More records appear to have it in the 521 field when they are imported from OCLC. Should we recommend that Guided Reading Level use 521 instead of 526? (10 min.)
